- Reading and approval of minutes from November, 2018 SPPTO meeting
- Financial Update
 - Christmas Program Concessions - \$115 net profit; roughly \$150 down from last year.
 - Breakfast With Santa - \$2800 net profit; up roughly \$500 from last year.
 - Christmas Poinsettia Sales – about \$650 net profit; up about \$400 from last year.
 - Year-to-date, we are still down about \$2,000 in order to allocate the same for next year.
 - \$21,000 currently in account; \$10,000 allocated for the remainder of the year.
 - We would need at least \$6,000 by the end of the year to allocate the same for next year.
- Registration Packets
 - Will be sent home with students on 1/22/19.
 - There will be only 1 all-encompassing fee to include everything necessary instead of the checklist provided in years past.
 - There will be a \$25 discount/child if packets are submitted by 1/27/19.
 - No refunds on registration fees.
 - Tuition assistance information will be included in the packets. Some scholarships are first come, first served. Call Teresa Boehmer with any questions.
 - \$500 new family referral bonus (information to be included in packets).
