- Reading and approval of minutes from April, 2019 SPPTO meeting
- Review of the activities/gifts for Teacher Appreciation Week – Melt-down Monday (ice cream), Ticket Tuesday (scratch-offs), ‘Wiches’ Wednesday (catered box lunch), Thankful Thursday (thank-you notes from students), High-Five Friday (gum and ribbons).
- Financial Update
 - \$21,277 currently in account; \$2,200 allocated for the remainder of the year. Still need to pay the invoice for plant sales from the Spring Sale from the account.
 - Still finalizing numbers from the Spring Sale.
 - Total fundraising income for the 2018-2019 school year so far - \$12,600.
- Walk-A-Thon Update (5/15/19)
 - \$1,821 has been raised in online donations so far.
 - Molly Molitor reviewed teacher-involved incentives if certain fundraising goals are met. Some teachers/staff will get silly-stringed, some will get pies in their faces, Ms. Kaimann will get water-ballooned at \$2,000 raised and Father Blessing will get a bucket of ice water dumped on him at \$2,500.
 - All of these events will take place during Field Day on Friday, May 17th.
 - In need of volunteers for the morning of the event (7:30am – roughly 10:00am).
 - Molly Molitor discussed the different activity stations that will be part of the walk (bubbles, tattoos, face-painting, hula hoops, etc).
 - The Walk-A-Thon will replace the current Tom Evans fundraising event in the Fall, if successful and reaches goal of \$2,500.

- SPPTO Officer Nomination and Elections for 2019-2020 school year.

- Discussion on sending out sign-up genius before the 2019 Open House to get volunteers for event chairs for the year and then discuss further during the Open House itself.
