We have about one week left in our Show Me Dough Fundraiser!


Please keep the following things in mind:

Alive! In Christ is first-come, first served for all new awards and younger siblings that may be eligible, so we strongly encourage you to apply as early as possible

The application <u>deadline</u> for Beyond Sunday, Catholic Families Tuition Assistance (CFTA), and the Parish Employees Endowment Fund (PEEF) is February 28th, 2024. Any family who would like to be considered for these programs, even if you are applying for requalification, must apply between January 22th and February 28th, 2024.

#### IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- If you have ever applied to TTEF before or are currently on scholarship, you must use the email address TTEF have on file for you.
