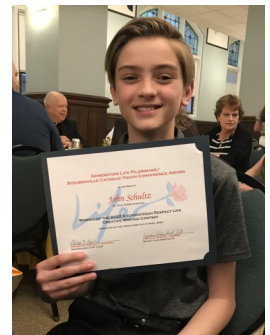

Help those in the right mindset understand how bad abortion is.

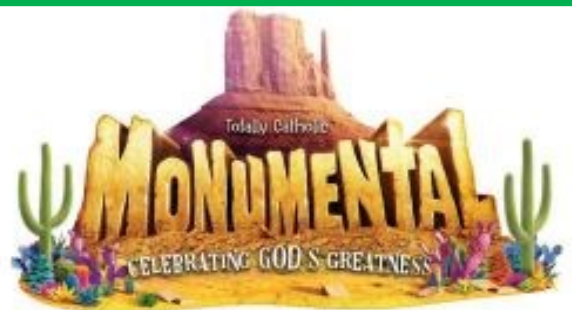
Give the doctors courage and strength to defend life.

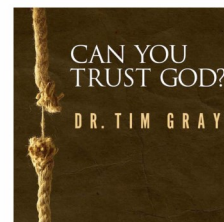
