School News/Reminders:

TeacherEase - St. Paul School is using the TeacherEase Student Information System - ALL PARENTS MUST log into TeacherEase to verify and update your student's information - THANK YOU!

The system can also send text messages and make voice calls. Here is a short video that describes how to setup your preferences: <u>Video of Setting Up Communication Preferences</u>. You need to do a small amount of setup to receive these messages. Login to TeacherEase and click "Communication Preferences." You can choose whether to receive emails, mobile app notifications, text messages, and/ or voice calls. We support two types of announcements: "school closure" and "other information," choose how you'd like to receive these messages: Everyone can choose email. If you've installed the TeacherEase mobile app, you can choose app notifications. If your mobile phone number is in the system, you can choose to receive texts and voice calls. If your phone number(s) are NOT listed, they are likely not in the system. Feel free to contact the school and provide them with updated information.

Chromebook – In order for students in grades 1-8 to have access to a Chromebook you must log onto TeacherEase and complete the Computer Acceptable Use Agreement and the Chromebook Insurance Form. Both of these can be found in the Registration section of TeacherEase when you log in. If you have any questions please contact the school office.

Click "Register" below the LOG IN button (image at right).

Enter the passcode stlprotect when prompted.

Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee

Parish or Parish School

Select the specific location by name

St. Paul Parish and School (St. Paul)

Click the roles associated with your employment/service at the parish.

If you are active at only one location, this will be your "primary" location.

If you are active at more than one location, click the ADD PARISH/LOCATION button and repeat the steps above. With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Complete your personal information. Please enter your **legal first name** for the purposes of the background screening.

Create a username, password and password clue.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to the address below. We will apply the correct training record to your account.

Use may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.



- **DISMISSAL PROCEDURES- Parents are to remain at their vehicle at ALL times**. We will bring your children to you.
- Pre-Kindergarten in the car/carpool You will park in the parking lot in the rear of school. We ask that
 you back into you space for the safety of all during dismissal. USING EVERY SPACE even handicap.
- Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade students in the car/carpool You will be lining up in the SCHOOL PARKING LOT in TWO rows facing Church Road. Please pull up to the car in front of you and put your car in "park". If you are the first to arrive you will need to pull up to the end of the lot.**NOTE: If you need to turn right out of the school parking lot (toward the K.C. Hall) please be sure to get in the line closest to the school. Otherwise both lines will be turning left out of the school parking lot.
- 3rd through 8th grade students in car/ carpool You will be lining up in the CHURCH PARKING LOT directly across from the school AND in the GRAVEL PARKING LOT. If you park on the black top you need to face Church Road. No one is to leave by the south side (cemetery side) of the church. Parents parking in the gravel lot MUST face north (toward the K.C. Hall) and MUST dismiss in that direction. You may not go south out of the gravel lot. PLEASE do not leave the gravel lot until cones are removed for you to exit. We will only be dismissing from ONE gravel lot exit this year. (please see the diagram)
- LATE ARRIVALS If you arrive late please park in the Quilters Lot (by the ballpark) or the KC lot and wait for the school lot to be reopened. Once the cones are removed you may enter the school lot for late pick up. PLEASE DO NOT EVER INITIALLY PARK IN THE QUILTERS LOT OR THE BASEBALL DIAMOND LOT, and walk over to pick up your child. If you choose to do this we will dismiss your children as walkers AFTER the parking lot is cleared and safe.
