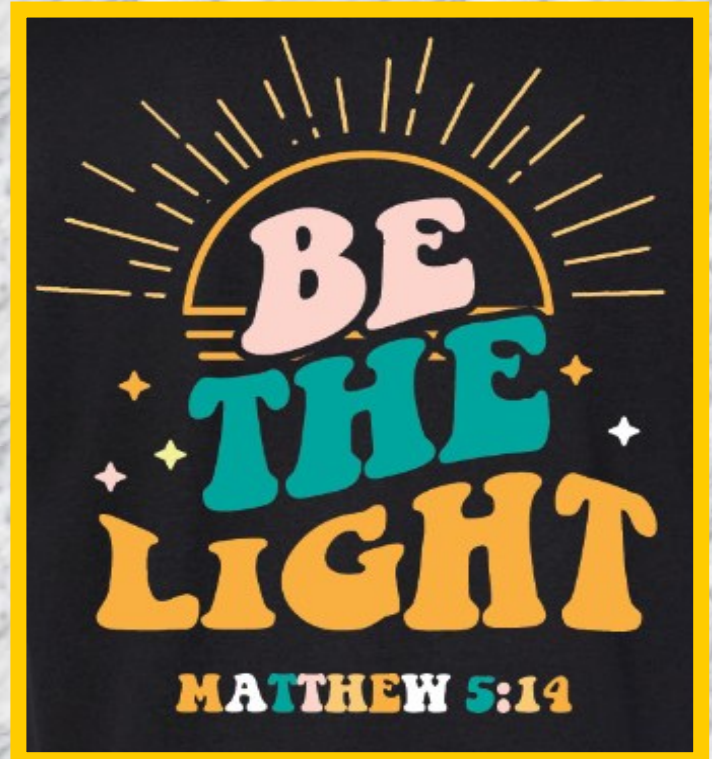

School News/Reminders:

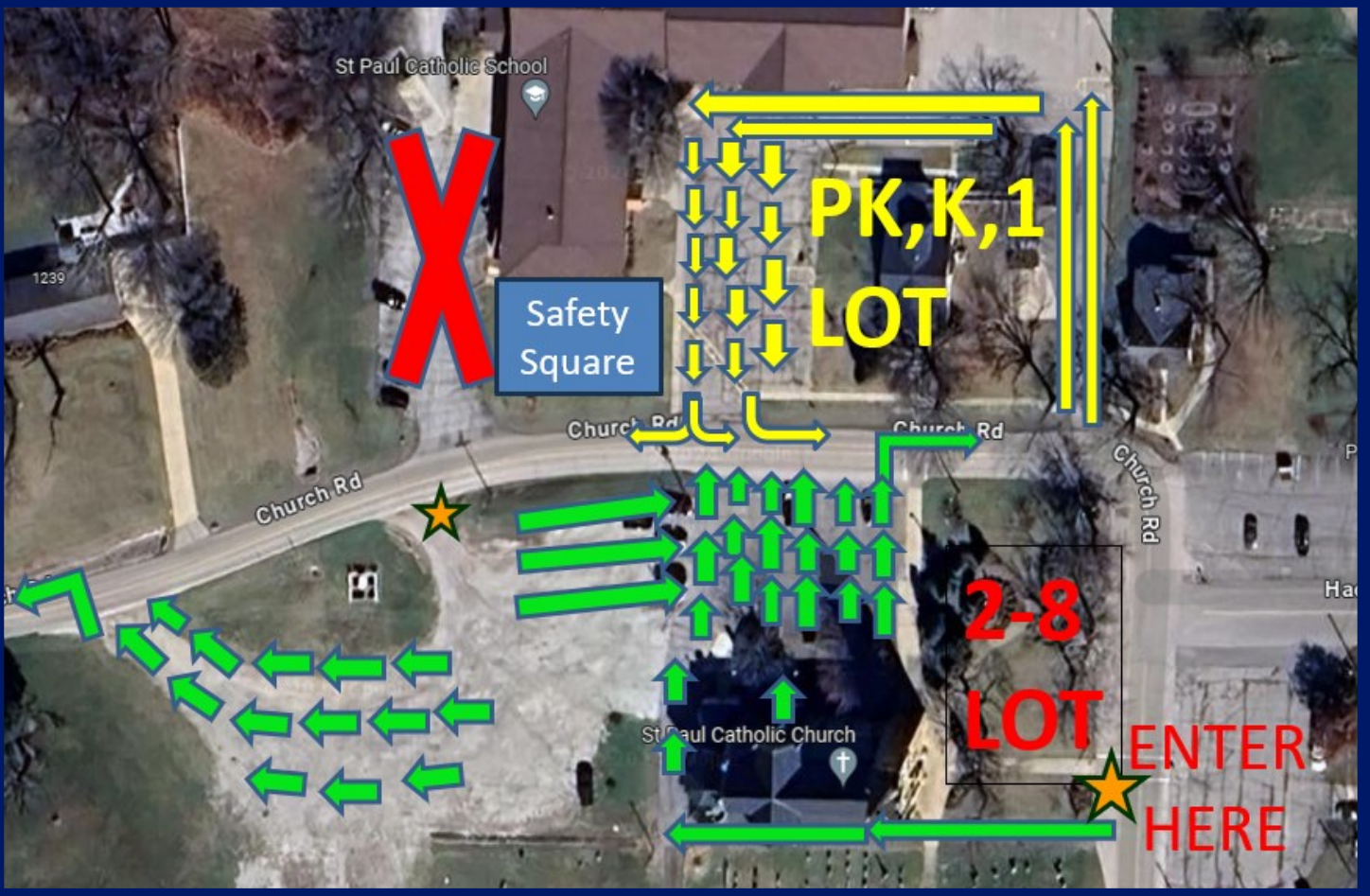
NEW DISMISSAL PROCEDURES- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten/First Grade (If the youngest rider is in PK or grade 1)-Enter by Parish Center drive line up in the SCHOOL PARKING LOT in THREE rows facing Church Road. Please pull up to the car in front of you and put your car in "park". If you are the first to arrive you will need to pull up to the end of the lot. ****NOTE:** If you need to turn right out of the school parking lot (toward the K.C. Hall) please be sure to get in the line closest to the school. Otherwise, all lines will be turning left out of the school parking lot. **ONCE THE LOT IS SECURED YOU WILL NEED TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP FROM THE SAFETY AREA/SQUARE AND WALK DIRECTLY TO YOUR CAR AND BUCKLE UP!!** The lot will not be dismissed until all children are in their vehicle.

2nd through 8th grade students in car/ carpool – Enter the parking lot on Church Road drive between the cemetery and the church drive all the way around and line up in the CHURCH PARKING LOT directly across from the school AND in the GRAVEL PARKING LOT. If you park on the black top you need to face Church Road. No one is to leave by the south side (cemetery side) of the church. Parents parking in the gravel lot **MUST** face north (toward the K.C. Hall) and **MUST** dismiss in that direction. You may not go south out of the gravel lot. **PLEASE** do not leave the gravel lot until cones are removed for you to exit. We will only be dismissing from **ONE** gravel lot exit. (please see the diagram)

LATE ARRIVALS If you arrive late, please park in the Quilters Lot (by the ballpark) or the KC lot and wait for the school lot to be reopened. Once the cones are removed you may enter the school lot for late pick up. (Parish Center Drive)

It is important to follow the guidelines of the parking lot for both the safety of the children and the fairness to those who are following the guidelines. SAFETY IS OUR MAIN FOCUS!!!!

Click "Register" below the LOG IN button (image at right).

Enter the passcode **stlprotect** when prompted.

Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee

- Parish or Parish School

Select the specific location by name

- St. Paul Parish and School (St. Paul)

Click the roles associated with your employment/service at the parish.

If you are active at only one location, this will be your "primary" location.

If you are active at more than one location, click the ADD PARISH/LOCATION button and repeat the steps above. With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Complete your personal information. Please enter your **legal first name** for the purposes of the background screening.

Create a username, password and password clue.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to the address below. We will apply the correct training record to your account.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
