

Enter the passcode [stlprotect](#) when prompted.

Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee

- Parish or Parish School

Select the specific location by name

- St. Paul Parish and School (St. Paul)

Click the roles associated with your employment/service at the parish.

If you are active at only one location, this will be your "primary" location.

With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to the address below. We will apply the correct training record to your account.

Use may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.



WHAT IS TWB/SCRIP?

Welcome back to all of our returning families and to our new families, we are glad to have you! Together We're Better (TWB) is a gift card sales program. Each day school family is required to earn \$250 in rebates by May 22nd, 2024. Scrip are gift cards purchased through our account that can be used for everyday shopping needs not just as gifts. Some major retailers that most families purchase scrip for and shop from on a weekly basis are Walmart, Target, Exxon Mobil and Dierbergs. The rebates vary from 1% to 18% depending on the card. For example a Walmart card which is also good at Sam's Club has a 2.5% rebate, if you purchased a \$100 scrip card for Walmart to

purchase household goods and groceries that you buy weekly, you would earn \$2.50 towards your obligation. To make things even easier once you purchase one card through the office you can log into your shopwithscrip.com account and select Walmart and the reload now option, then you can reload the card yourself and continue to reuse it. A third option for purchasing scrip through us is through the app, you can purchase a scrip now ecard from select retailers right from your phone while you are shopping or dining out. There is an enrollment code associated with St. Paul so that your family receives credit for the purchases. There are over 750 retailers you

can purchase cards from including restaurants, specialty stores, movie tickets, entertainment venues and even hotels and carnival cruises. So meeting the obligation can be easily done.

Several times throughout the school year we will do preorders on local vendors. Please watch for emails through teacher ease when these are available to order and their deadlines.

Watch for emails sent through teacher ease throughout the year with bonus buy information and program updates.

If you have any questions or need help setting up an account please don't hesitate to reach out.



ST. PAUL LEARNING CENTER NEWS FROM MRS. HARR


