Dear St. Paul Parents,

This fall we will begin the transition from the Riverside Iowa test to the NWEA MAP Growth Assessment. As part of an Archdiocesan-wide initiative, we will spend the next two years making this change. The Archdiocese began piloting NWEA during the 2022-2023 school year in 8 schools, and last school year, 26 Archdiocesan elementary schools administered the assessment. This year every school will be assessing using NWEA in at least two grade levels. This year we will be giving the NWEA Assessment in Kindergarten-Sixth grades and will continue the Riverside Iowa Assessment in grades Seventh and Eighth.

The NWEA MAP Growth Assessment is a benchmark assessment composed of Math, Reading, Language Usage. The students will take each of these sections 3 times a year during the testing windows. The three testing windows will occur from August 19th- September 13th (Window 1), January 6th- January 31st (Window 2), and April 21st- May 9th (Window 3). While there is greater frequency in the tests, each section of the test lasts roughly 45 minutes and should lead to much less taxing testing experiences for our students.

The NWEA MAP Growth Assessment is computer adaptive, meaning that the test is dynamic and adjusts the difficulty of questions based on a student's responses. The questions begin at grade level, and as a student gets questions correct or incorrect, the test adapts above or below grade level to find the student's ability level. Our school is excited to use this test because its adaptive nature along with multiple data points will allow us to focus more on promoting individual student and class growth, supporting student needs, and getting more frequent feedback on the impact of our instructional practices.

Click "Register" below the LOG IN button (image at right).

Enter the passcode **stlprotect** when prompted.

Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee

- Parish or Parish School

Select the specific location by name

- St. Paul Parish and School (St. Paul)

Click the roles associated with your employment/service at the parish.

If you are active at only one location, this will be your "primary" location.

If you are active at more than one location, click the ADD PARISH/LOCATION button and repeat the steps above. With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Complete your personal information. Please enter your **legal first name** for the purposes of the background screening.

Create a username, password and password clue.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop\*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

\*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to the address below. We will apply the correct training record to your account.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
