Let's Code It - The Digital Dimension. Learn to #code with Afterschool Enrichment Solutions! Both new and returning participants are welcome. 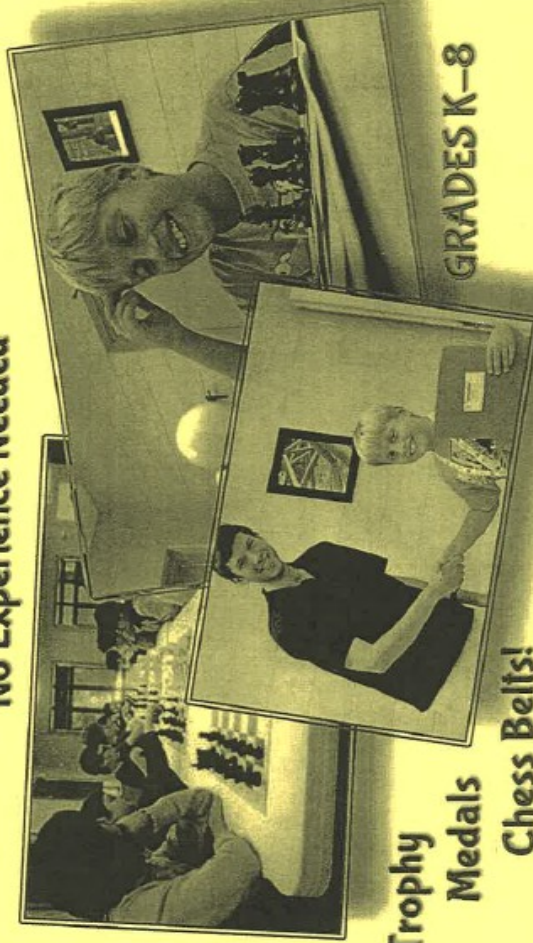
