First things first, we have the Belt of Truth......our very own belt looks awesome!! Thank you to all of the families that turned in their belt. If you would still like to add to it, its not too late!


Today was a beautiful day as we were all able to spend some time with Jesus in the adoration chapel. We are so blessed to have this wonderful opportuity to be with Jesus.



Let's Build It - Chain Reaction in Action! The ball rolls down the ramp, turns the switch, that moves the post, that activates the zip-line, that knocks the ball down the ramp and into the goal! In this STEAM program, students will be building Rube Goldberg "Mouse Trap" chain-reaction machines featuring levers, pulleys, and other simple machines. Engineering and physics concepts will be introduced and reinforced through hands-on, innovative lessons and creative play time. Problem solving skills and teamwork will be put to the test as the complexity of the projects increases from week to week. On the final class, there will be a building competition - How many contraptions can you connect in chain reaction? No previous experience is necessary, just a desire to learn and build. Each student will receive an award on the last day of the session, and have the opportunity to earn Energy Belts to demonstrate their learned skills!


Faith Works!
