regular dismissal.



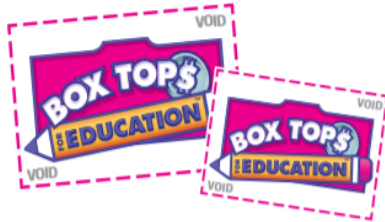
