#### S.T.R.E.A.M.

#### September

We began STREAM classes in K-8 grades by getting to know one another and doing activities and builds using coins.

Later in September we did activities related to the faith Noah must have had to build an ark. Unfortunately, 2nd Grade missed one class due to ITBS scheduling.

Kindergarteners sorted toy animals 2 by 2.
