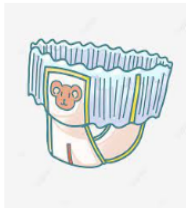

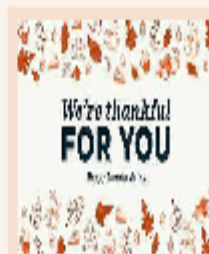

### S.T.R.E.A.M.

#### September

We began STREAM classes in K-8 grades by getting to know one another and doing activities and builds using coins.



- 5. Adults are able to answer hotline calls or make home visits**

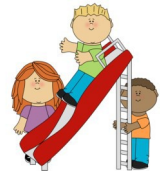

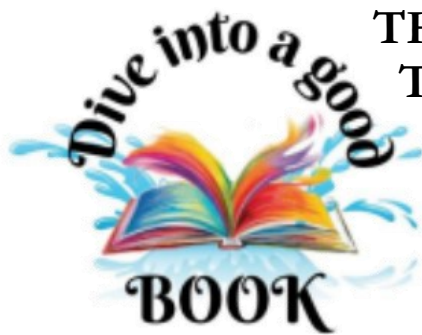
