St. Paul Grandparents Day 2024

All Grandparents or special guests are invited to our Grandparents Day Mass and Celebration on Wednesday, November 27, 2024 Details below:

- Grandparents may arrive beginning at 7:30AM.
- Parking will be available in the Church Lot, Gravel Lot, Pre-K Lot, in front of school, and the new back parking lot.
- Due to the large number of attendees, Mass will be held in the GYM and will start at 8:00AM
- Students do not need to bring backpacks.

ARRIVAL CHOICES

- Students may arrive at school with their grandparent(s). Students should check in with their teacher, who will be in the gym, and sit with their grandparent(s) for mass.
- Students may arrive as normal in the drop-off line. They will meet their teacher in the gym to check in, and their grandparent(s) will meet the student(s) in the gym and sit together for mass.

ACTIVITIES AFTER MASS:

- After Mass students will play bingo with their Grandparents in the gym.
- After bingo refreshments and coffee will be served and then the grandparents and students will have the opportunity to visit classrooms, tour the school and interact with the classes.
- Your child is welcome to leave with their grandparents afterwards. Students need to be signed out with their classroom teacher before leaving.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to the address below. We will apply the correct training record to your account.

Use may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
