The Street People are **in dire need** of the following new or used items in order to transition the homeless into the colder upcoming months:

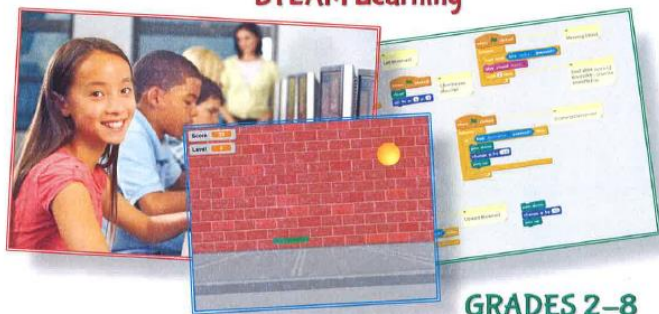

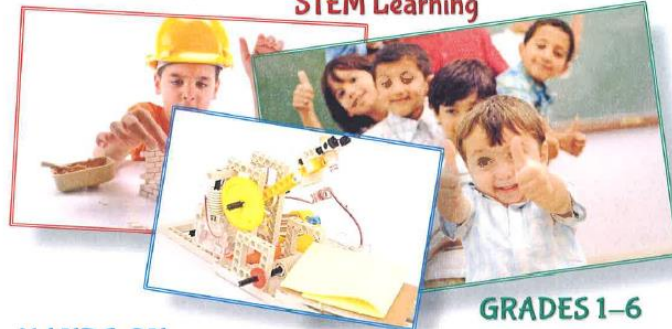

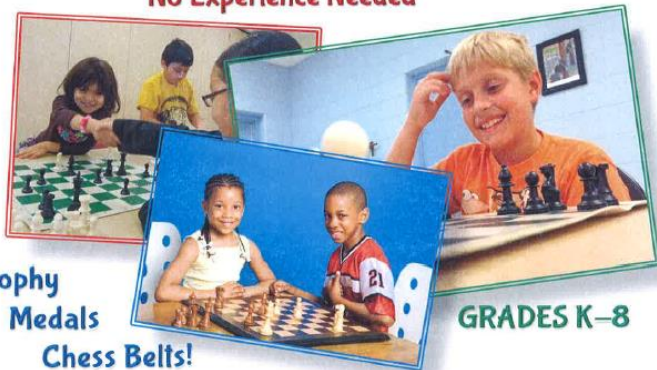
