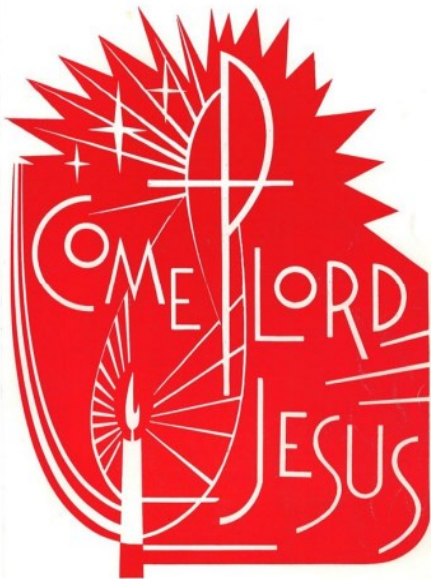


Illness / Medication

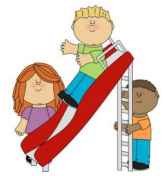
