# **NWEA**

Dear Parents,

This fall we will continue the transition from the Riverside Iowa test to the NWEA MAP Growth Assessment. As part of an Archdiocesan-wide initiative, we are in our second year of making this change.

The NWEA MAP Growth Assessment is a benchmark assessment composed of Math, Reading, Language Usage. The students will take each of these sections 3 times a year during the testing widows. We will be taking the first testy next week in grades 1-8. While there is greater frequency in the tests, each section of the test lasts roughly 45 minutes and should lead to much less taxing testing experiences for our students.

The NWEA MAP Growth Assessment is computer adaptive, meaning that the test is dynamic and adjusts the difficulty of questions based on a student's responses. The questions begin at grade level, and as a student gets questions correct or incorrect, the test adapts above or below grade level to find the student's ability level. Our school is excited to use this test because its adaptive nature along with multiple data points will allow us to focus more on promoting individual student and class growth, supporting student needs, and getting more frequent feedback on the impact of our instructional practices.

# What is TWB/RaiseRight?

Welcome back to all of our returning families and to our new families, we are glad to have you! Together We're Better (TWB) is a gift card sales program. Each day school family is required to earn \$250 in rebates by May 10th, 2026. Gift cards purchased through our account that can be used for everyday shopping needs not just as gifts. Some major retailers that most families purchase for and shop from on a weekly basis are Walmart, Target, Exxon Mobil and Dierbergs. The rebates vary from 1% to 18% depending on the card. For example a Walmart card which is also good at Sam's Club has a 2.5% rebate, if you purchased a \$100 gift card for Walmart to purchase household goods and groceries that you buy weekly, you would earn \$2.50 towards your obligation. To make things even easier once you purchase one card through the office you can log into your www.raiseright.com account and select Walmart and the reload now option, then you can reload the card yourself and continue to reuse it. A third option for purchasing gift cards through us is with the app, you can purchase an eGift Card from select retailers right from your phone while you are shopping or dining out. There is an enrollment code associated with St. Paul so that your family receives credit for the purchases. There are over 750 retailers you can purchase cards from including restaurants, specialty stores, movie tickets, entertainment venues and even hotels and carnival cruises. So meeting the obligation can be easily done.

Several times throughout the school year we will do preorders on local vendors. Please watch for emails through teacher ease when these are available to order and their deadlines.

Watch for emails sent through teacher ease throughout the year with bonus buy information and program updates.




